BEGINNING BASICS

There are some 'best practices' everyone on Twitter should follow –

- 1. Complete your profile and have a focus.
- 2. Be selective when following.
- 3. Start (and keep on!) tweeting! Communicate!
- 4. Make use of #hashtags.
- 5. Network and engage!

COMPLETE YOUR PROFILE & HAVE A FOCUS!

- Add your avatar an actual photo, cartoon, logo of YOU!
- Complete your bio Three sentences (or less) to tell what you do, add interest, and show your personality.
- Use a hashtag to 'brand' yourself! #booknerd

Focus – Let others know what to expect from you and your

tweets.




BE SELECTIVE WHEN FOLLOWING!

One of the unspoken rules of Twitter –

DON'T AUTOMATICALLY FOLLOW EVERYONE WHO FOLLOWS YOU!





BE SELECTIVE WHEN FOLLOWING!

- Be patient, grasshopper.
- ii. Let them come to you.
- iii. It's not a competition. And ...

NO ONE REALLY CARES HOW MANY FOLLOWERS YOU HAVE!


START (AND KEEP!) TWEETING! COMMUNICATE!

 Too many people create an account and then just let it languish. Don't leave your account active if you aren't going to use it.

- Pace yourself!
- Tweet early, Tweet often. Ask questions. Join conversations about things that interest you.
 - Comment (using the "@", of course) on smart things your Twitter friends say. Say "thanks!" when others share good info.

MAKE USE OF #HASHTAGS.

- Keep an eye on what's trending
- Come up with your own #hashtag
- Find the key ones for your field and use them ALL OF THE TIME.
- Hashtags give your tweets a longer, more focused life. They connect you to people seeking out others in the same area or industry.
