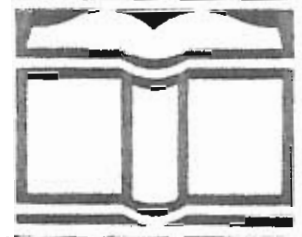

The second annual meeting of the Huronia Regional CALT/ABO was held in Collinswood on Feb 14, 1981.

Incident's report (synopsis)

Two recommendations from HRB have been acted upon by the Provincial Board of Directors. The Board set a policy on Oct. 4/80 to pay car travelling expenses for Directors and the Provincial Executive. The recommendation to have secret ballot voting for Provincial Executive elections at the ABK will be presented to the general membership for acceptance at the next annual business meeting. As this is a change in the constitution it must be voted on by the general membership.

Two statements from the Provincial Board of Directors were read, as well as two proposed by-law changes. Both of these are attached to this newsletter.
