

Where do you fit in?

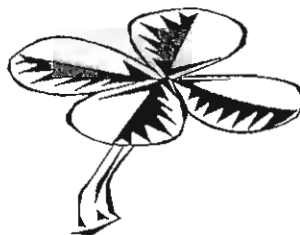

Level 1 Archives & Workrooms Archives Reading Room and storage area. Family histories, index print-outs, newspapers.

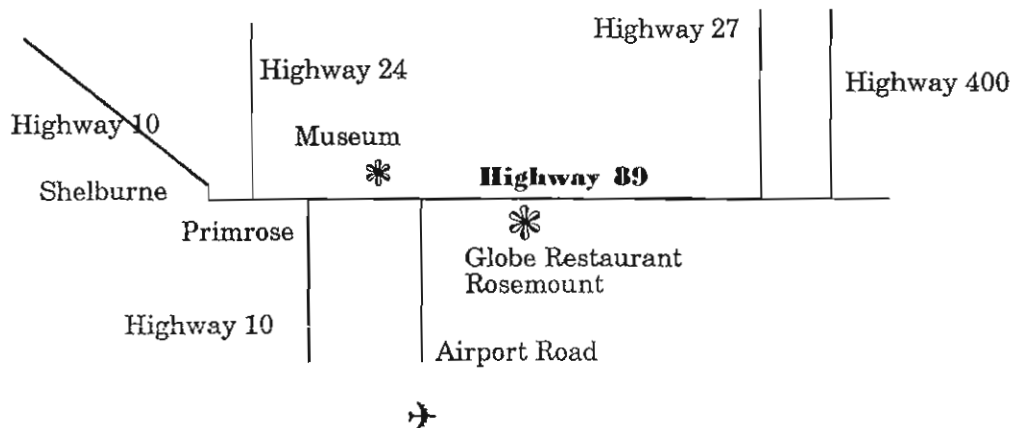
Mezzanine Level 3 an interesting perspective of exhibit buildings
