

# Cheeseball

4 oz. blue cheese 10 oz. cheese Whiz 14 oz. Cream cheese 1 tsp. worcestershire sauce ½ C. parsley 1 C chopped nuts (walnuts)



As this was the first all day meeting of the new executive and board of directors it was an introductory meeting to many as to how the executive and board of directors function. Petty Cash and other budgests were established for the comming year and an exchange of paper work and ideas from old positions to new took place. The treasury was reported to be healthy with approximately \$2,000 on hand. The Public Relations Co-ordinator (PRC) had prepared and distributed conference reports to the relevant library journals. An honorarium and letter of thanks was to be sent to the past Newsletter Editor and Membership Chairperson for their past work. A new Newsletter duo were proposed by Pat Boon of TALTA: Anna Marchione and Jackie Druery. Those present at the meeting prepared a list of suggestions for a new newsletter . format. Issue Volume 3, # 2 to be published by the end of the summer. It was announced that OALT/ABO would be presenting 4 workshops at the OLA Conference in London, in October.
