DIRECTOR'S REPORT

The provincial Board of Directors and Executive have been as busy as beavers since September 1981. The Proposal for Change (amendments to our provincial constitution), as presented by Paulette Thibault and Bette Heard, went to a committee for discussion and revision. All regions, with the exception of Sudbury, had a representative on this committee to present the regional views and to vote on each amendment. After two meetings (November 28, 1981 & January 9, 1982), the committee has completed a revised Proposal for Change, which will be presented to the provincial Board of Directors and Executive on February 6, 1982. These amendments will then be on the Annual Business Meeting agenda at the Conference for voting on. If you have any questions regarding these amendments please ask.

The Essay Contest is now open for submissions. Sheridan and Fanshawe have included the contest as a course requirement for their LT students. We are grateful for the support from both of these programmes.

Danielle Amat and Nancy Carlucci have been travelling southern Ontario to publicize our Association. At Fanshawe they signed up 28 new members, while in London a visit to Western University's Faculty of Library Science succeeded in 'raising our profile' with future librarians. There are also plans to visit the Faculties of Library Science at McGill University and the University of Toronto in January.

The Convention Procedures Manual has now been completed and distributed to the regions. A glossary will be added to the manual shortly. Many thanks to Paulette Thibault for her efforts.

Our provincial Secretary, Francine Lacasse, has resigned from the Executive to move west. Helen Luoma (TALTA region) has accepted the position of interim secretary.
