By-law 1, iv : Associate membership will be given to an individual interested in the development of Library Technicians.

change to : Associate membership will be given to an individual interested in the objectives of the organization.

Rationale: Associate members very often join for the reasons stated in Ojectives d) and e) of the Provincial Constitution.

The present wording of By-law 1, iv is too restrictive.

FURTHER THOUGHTS ON VOTING AT THE ANNUAL BUSINESS MEETING:


Whereas the majority of regions accord voting rights to all members in good standing, regardless of their classification within their region, it is proposed that at the Annual Business Meeting, associate members sit with their regions and participate in the region's discussions. Submissions to the floor should be made through the designated member.

When the item of New Business arises on the ABM Agenda, the floor should then be open to all for discussion.

FURTHER THOUGHTS ON SEATING ARRANGEMENTS AT THE ANNUAL BUSINESS MEETING:

No article or by-law in the Constitution specifies segregated seating for associate members.

Constitutional changes are discussed and voted on within each region by all its members prior to the ABM; therefore segregated seating is redundant.




