#### 1979 PRESIDENT'S REPORT

1979 has been an exciting year of growth for TALTA and this is largely due to the combined efforts of the Executive Committee, including the newsletter co-ordinator; the various Dimensions Conference Committees, under Peta Shelton's direction, and many other individuals who were willing to offer their services whenever called upon. There are just too many to thank in this short address but I'm sure we all know the people involved.

Membership has steadily increased over the year. At the end of 1978 we had 95 members and by the end of 1979 we were able to boast of 150 members.

We produced 5 informative newsletters, introduced the students of Seneca and Ryerson to OALT/ABO and TALTA through personal visits and held a number of very successful meetings e.g. Hilda Stollery's presentation on childrens books and storytelling, "Host-to-Host" - a post-conference luncheon meeting, Prof. Kurmey's talk on micro and mini computers, etc. Here I would like to add a special note of tranks to Dens Hansen for arranging TALTA's guest speakers and special programs over the past year.

A large part of TALTA'S success in 1979, was the interest generated by our hosting the 6th annual OALT/ABO conference, Dimensions, the most successful of our conferences to date. This helped to increase TALTA's reputation as a professional, well-established organization. We must devote ourselves to keeping up and expanding this image in 1980.
