Guest Speakers

The majority of the membership who did not attend the annual general meeting for a variety of reasons missed not only a beautiful and delicious buffet luncheon, but interesting and informative speeches.

From Janet Abernathy's presentation, <u>Literacy and the Reluctant Reader</u>, we learned about the magnitude of the illiteracy problem in Canada and the U.S. She defined the problem and suggested ways to correct it.

Linda Jewett, a librarian and law student, enlightened us about the present state of affairs concerning Canada's copyright law.

Karen Fraser, President of Women Like Me mentioned the courses she offers and the <u>Toronto Business Women's Directory</u> that she is publishing. Her talk focussed on our lifestyles, what they were, are now, and may be in the future. She said we need adaptive skills to cope with change during our lives. Among other things she added that with life expectancy getting longer adults are going to have two or three careers, have two or three marriages, and spend more years in school.

According to another member who attended the <u>Women's Credit Union</u> session, Katherine Devlin gave tips on how to use credit cards and how women could establish a credit rating. Did you know that when a man and woman marry, the woman's credit rating gets interfiled with her

husband's? A request must be made to get the files separated. Another point was brought up that when a family has multiple copies of a credit card only the main card holder whose name is on the bill gets a credit rating.

As your new newsletter editor this is my appeal to you to get your money's worth out of your membership fee and attend meetings. They are planned for you. There will be a new procedure for voting at the Annual Business Meeting. There will still be bloc voting (1 vote per region) on all items, i.e., constitution changes, membership fees, etc., but there will now be individual secret ballots for the election of the Provincial Executive. TALTA EXECUTIVE MEETING

The meeting was held Sept. 21. The items listed below were discussed.

AV PROPOSAL

Several members of the executive are checking with friends who are in the photography business to get their opinion and thus help us evaluate the proposal.

ASSOCIATE MEMBERS

Nancy Deas' constitution committee is looking into amending TALTA's constitution in order to bring it into line with the provincial's constitution. This will correct the discrepancy we have in regard to associate members and their fees.

ABM

Methods for streamlining the ABM were discussed with some useful suggestions arrived at.

- 1. An agenda for the ABM could be included in the conference kits with time limits for each item stated. These time limits would then be strictly adhered to in the meeting.
